

FROM THE TECHNICAL OFFICER OF F.A.R.S.

This is to advise you all that the European Committee have re-considered all the dance events for couples and solo and the attached details are the dances that will be skated in 2010 and 2011.

As far as the Junior and Senior is concerned, these are controlled by the World Committee and are as listed on the sheets.

Points that should be borne in mind by the Trainers, Skaters, Judges :-

In Senior Couples for 2010 the Castel March will be skated and this DVD was first available over 2 years ago and announced in the Gazette and on the original web site. This was also demonstrated at the last two World Championships and will be demonstrated again in Freiburg, Germany, during the World Championships.

There will also be a demonstration of the Tango Delanco, a new dance for Senior couples. This is a difficult dance and will be put in the schedule in the future. A DVD of this is also available.

For the Minis Couples and Solo there are two new simple dances the City Blues for couples in 2010 and the Carlos Tango for Solo in 2010. These are also available on DVD and we will demonstrate them during different Championships and Competitions for the rest of the International Season.

Please note in Couples:-

For Espoir there will be a simple Free Dance of 2 ½ mins as from 2010, and only 2 Dances in Cadet and Youth with a Free Dance.

Please note for Solo:-

For Espoir there will be a simple Free Dance of 2 mins as from 2010. The OSP remains in Cadet Solo, and in Youth Solo from 2010 there will be a Free Dance of 2½ mins.
